ABP broadcasters, which had ownership with Star TV until 2012, reach 48 million screens per week with a vast network of free to air TV channels based across India. On the mission to keep each individual ahead and informed, the ABP Network delivers insightful analysis of news and current affairs, and entertainment in 8 languages through linear TV and digital platforms.



A BLAST FROM THE PAST

The deployment of Octopus NRCS for ABP's newsrooms went down in history. The first installation was carried out for Star News during the autumn of 2006 in Noida, the company's headquarters.

Star News, ABP News' ancestor, was on the lookout for a system that could offer advanced capabilities to revamp storytelling. Octopus was ready to provide the demanded newsroom system for a masterful command of news production including tools to manage live and uninterrupted broadcasting, conduct research, optimize news gathering, and more. Most importantly, it allowed the integration between the MCR and the PCR to control daily traffic of the content produced inside and outside the studio. It also seamlessly integrated with ABP News' third-party MOS-compliant systems, including PCR playout, graphics, and teleprompter devices. Likewise, ABP's family of channels including ABP Asmita in Ahmedabad, ABP Ananda in Kolkata, and ABP Majha in Mumbai rely on Octopus for their news production.

As well as the multisite production that allows all ABP broadcasters to interconnect several Octopus systems to share content nationwide between regions and channels.

Remarkably, new licenses for Octopus X have been purchased by ABP News to cover all users within the channels.
