ABOUT

Dunya News provides 24-hour broadcast and streaming options for news and current affairs in Pakistan. The most trusted and notable journalists and hosts from the country bring public affairs, breaking news breakdowns, and entertainment to the global masses with channels that read the United Kingdom and the United States of America. The network is part of the Punjab Group of Colleges and was founded by political and business mogul Mian Amer Mahmood.

Dunya News was launched in 2008 at a time when a free press was more of a dream than reality. With smart, clever, and careful programming, the team at Dunya has created a must-see product on linear, non-linear, and social channels. Dunya TV provides coverage of every district in Pakistan with bureaus globally in the United Arab Emirates, United Kingdom, and the USA. As of November 2022, Dunya was in the Top 5 Highest-Rated Networks.

CHANNELS

Dunya News has a global reach but doesn't cater to the global crowd, opting instead to bring Punjabi news, talk shows, rhetoric, and satire in Urdu language to the world. Lahore News is the second channel that is geo-cached to the city of Lahore and its audience of potentially 10 million people. Within the channels, the sub-culture of public affairs, talk shows, and satire shows required a newsroom computer system that could collaborate on a grand scale while silo separate staffing groups as needed.









OCTOPUS & DUNYA NEWS

Dunya entered its 14th year of operation with the newlylaunched Octopus system. The relationship started in 2015, and as Dunya expanded and Octopus became a global solution for broadcasters, the relationship was sealed in 2022. As two global powerhouse companies, it was important to meet the needs of an evolving landscape but also required an escalated configuration to installation to training to launch period that broke all records (and language barriers) previously established. Octopus' integration with major vendors like VIZRT, which does Dunya's real-time graphics, made the advanced timeline even more achievable.

Innovation matters, but reputation builds partnerships. The thorough research done by Dunya's executive team showed Octopus was not just a solution - but the best one to replace an aging system.

One of the top questions Octopus team members get when talking with potential new clients is, "Will this work with my systems?" The exhaustive list of third-party vendor synchronicity is as impressive as the Octopus tech's ability to create adaptions with new systems or location-specific products.
